



## **Top FIVE Ways to Use A Quick Guide to Anabaptist Values and The Quickest Ever DVD Guide to Anabaptists and Their Values**

1. Show the DVD at your next staff and/or board meeting to get their responses. (Make the booklet available as well.)
2. Use both in your new staff and new board member training and orientation
3. Use both to stimulate values and culture discussion with board and staff
4. Make them available on a “library loan” basis to all interested staff (maybe from your Human Resources department)
5. When they have outlived their usefulness (maybe when David Letterman has retired) you can: recycle them, use the book for bird or hamster cage lining, use the DVD as an indoor Frisbee. (Okay, just kidding on this one.)

### **More ideas:**

- Use them with any group that relates to your organization to begin a discussion about your background as an organization and to discover theirs.
- Use them with clergy that relate to your organization regularly.
- Use them sometime as part of a presentation you give at an area service club or to a church group to generate discussion of your values as an organization and theirs as a congregation.

3. Where do you see these?
4. What gifts and insights do you feel you bring to your involvement with our organization?
5. Have you felt welcomed and accepted in your involvement with us?
